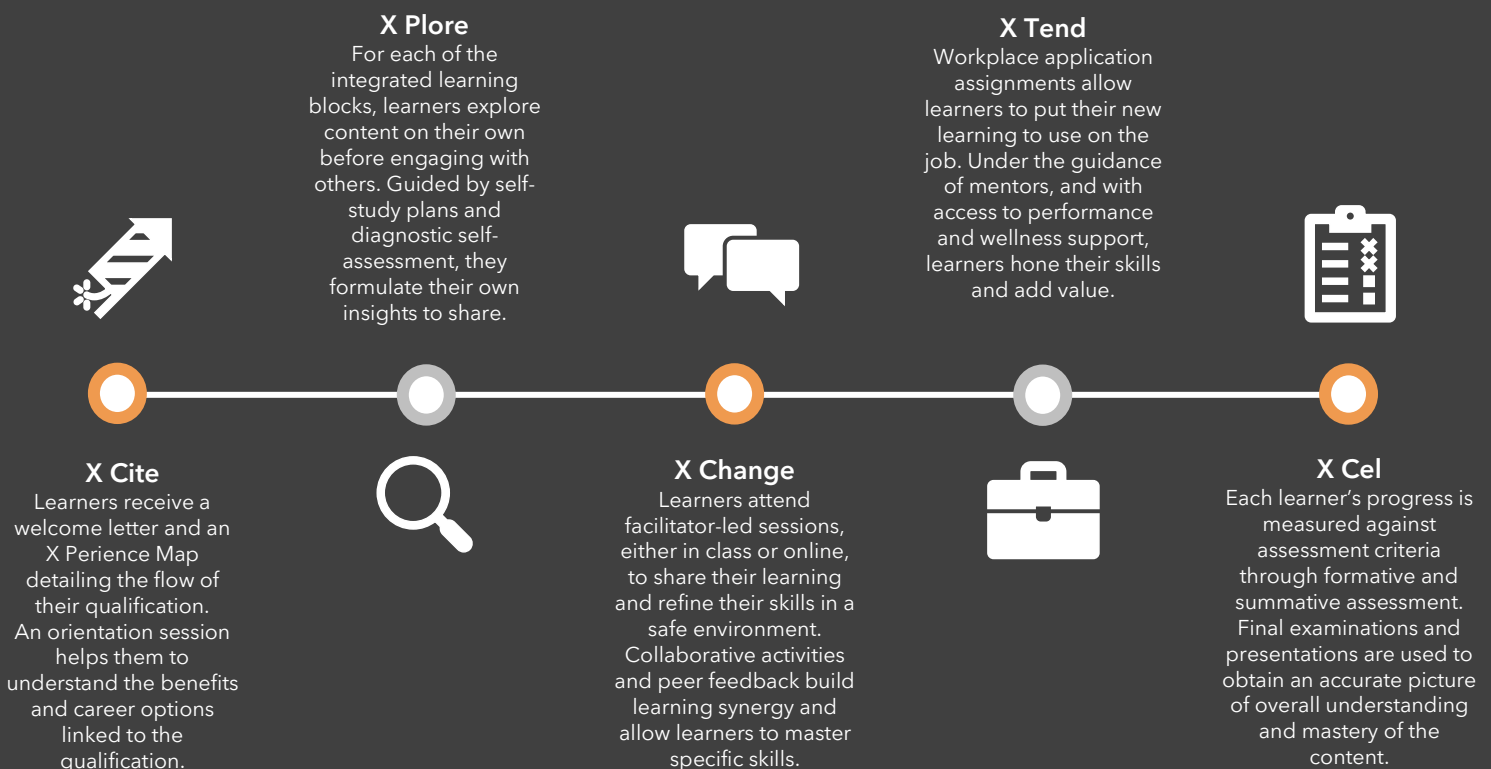
The importance of a progression path in support of continuous professional development within the supply chain sector, aligned to requirements of international professional bodies in this sector, becomes increasingly important in a global environment.
